<p>Humanities</p>	<p>To draw or print out the four flags for England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales.</p>	<p>To walk to your local post office and post a letter.</p>	<p>Create a family timeline and write down where each person was born. For example Miss Denton was born in Reading.</p>
