


## Term: Summer 1 – Top of the World

<b>Maths</b>	Find the height of the tallest to 10 mountains and order them. Convert the heights into m, cm and mm.	Find out what percentage of the world is covered in Mountains.  Convert this into a fraction and a decimal.  If 32 % more of the land becomes mountains. How much would now be covered in mountains?	Simon Beck is a snow artist who has made this in the snow of the Alps.  Can you use shapes to make your own snow patterns?	 Write five questions and answers from the graph.
<b>Science</b>	How are mountains formed? Create an explanation text to explain how they are created.	Research an animal which lives in the Alps and describe its habitat and how it is adapted to live in the environment. Create your own animal which could live in the mountains.	In your house, what can you find which changes its state when heat or cold is applied to it? Which changes are reversible? Which ones are irreversible?	Create an information sheet about mountains that have been discovered on other planets.
<b>Humanities</b>	Use an atlas and the internet to plan a trip through the Alps. Where will you stop? How long will it take you? How far will you travel? What will you need to pack?	Who was the first person to successfully climb Mount Everest? Imagine you are them and write a recount about your trip.	Use Imovie to create a video about The Alps.	Create your own creation story about how mountains were formed.
