Things you need



A pair of welly boots

We need these when we are outside and it is wet and mucky! They can live in school so you do not have to keep taking them home. They will also need your name on so they do not get lost.



Ask your grown up if you need a packed lunch.

Eating a healthy lunch helps us to concentrate and work well. Some children will have a lunch box and some children will have a hot school meal made by our school cooks.



P.E kit

You will need black shorts and a white t-shirt. You will also need a pair of plimsoles or trainers so you can run fast!

Your P.E kit will stay on your peg in school all week and go home on every Friday.



A water bottle

Drinking water is important to keep us healthy. You should bring a named water bottle to school every day. We keep them safe in the water bottle trays in your classroom so you can have a drink whenever you need one.

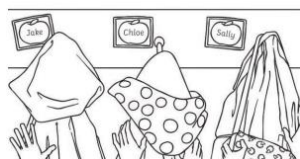

My day...



At the start of the day, you will give your grown-up a cuddle and wave goodbye to them at your classroom door. Your teacher will show you where everything goes and help you get ready for the day. Here are some pictures to help you.



Hang up your coat on your coat peg – look for your special name label.



Keep your water bottle safe all day in the water station tray.



If you have a lunch box keep it safe in our special box.



There will be a special box to keep your book bag and reading diary safe.



There will be a box to put your jumper or cardigan in if you take it off.



This is the carpet area where we sit for the register, listen to stories and to do some learning.

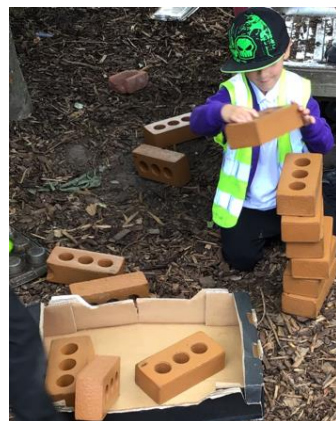
When you have said goodbye to your grown up, each day we will do a register to see who is in school. We do the register in the morning and again after lunch. Then we will have some time on the carpet in our classroom. Sometimes, we will go into the hall for assembly.

Learning outside...

Throughout the day, we will play inside and outside.



You can have fun splashing in the water. Fill up containers, estimate and measure.



These children are trying to build a house. Look how tall their wall is!



You can have fun racing trikes and scooters.



You can play on the climbing frames.

You can have lots of fun in our Mud Kitchen; cooking mud pies, mud cakes, mud pizza or mud milkshakes.



We can use the garden even if it's raining outside and have fun learning under the covered area.



Every day we have snack café inside and outside. You can choose a piece of fruit and have a carton of milk whilst chatting with your friends.

Learning inside...

In the classroom, we have lots of things to play with too. We have construction toys, dinosaurs, cars, animals, dolls, playdough, games and lots and lots of things to use for drawing, painting and making models.



You will safely cook delicious food and treats in our kitchen with an adult.



We like using our imaginations to build things using the construction equipment.



You can come and look at and read the books in our cosy, quiet reading area.



You can have lots of fun in the home corner; cook dinner, order a take away or look after a baby. We change our role play areas every term so you can learn about lots of different things.



We have writing and maths areas where you can learn to write and count.

Going to the toilet...

When you are playing and you need the toilet or to wash your hands you can go on your own.



We have two sets of toilets you can use.



This is where you wash your hands. It is important to use soap and dry them with the hand dryer.

Lunchtime...



We have lunchtime in the middle of the day. We all eat together in the dining hall. The lunchtime controllers and your teachers are there to help if you need them.

After our lunch, we go to play in the top playground. We can play on the pirate ship or play other games with our friends.



Some people bring a packed lunch and some have school dinners.

At the end of the day ...



At the end of the afternoon, it will be **home time**.

We read a story together on the carpet and sing some songs.

Then we collect our coat, book bag, water bottle and any pictures we want to take home.



We say goodbye to our friends and wait on the carpet until our teacher calls us to let us know a grown-up has arrived to collect us.

Some children will stay at school for a bit longer and go to an after school club.
