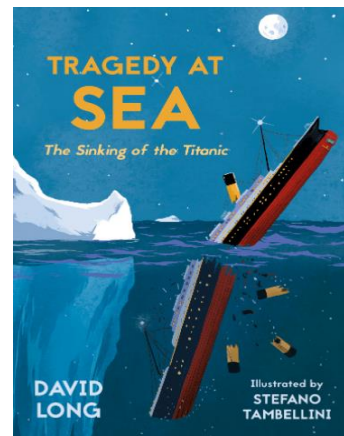


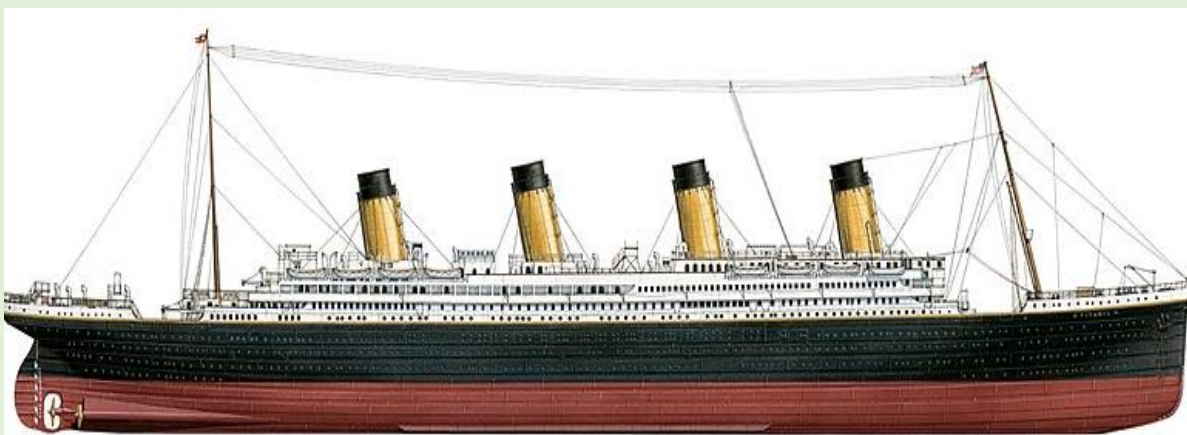
Book Knowledge Organiser – Tragedy at Sea: The Sinking of the Titanic
