

Plot - Zoe runs from a group of people chasing her and excapes in her boat called 'Lyca' which she found and patched up. The seas are rising and the world is running out of land. She lands on Eel Island where life is just as difficult and unsavourty characters are out to look after only themselves. Zoe explains that her parents accidentally left her behind when boats came to rescue them and she has been searching for them ever since.

<u>Setting</u> - Initially set in Norwich, a south-eastern city in England, the novel is set in the future where the sea is constantly rising and reducing the amount of land, causing poverty, crime and everyone fending for themselves. Zoe ends up rowing to a small island with a cathedral as its central building.

<u>Themes</u> - climate change, global warming, loneliness, courage, trust, perseverance, determination.
