History	Why was Tutankhamun's tomb an important discovery?
History	Why do you think there are similarities and differences between the ancient Sumer and the ancient Egyptian civilisations?

History	How were Indus Valley cities similar or different to those of ancient Sumer and ancient Egypt?
History	What were the roles of merchants, goods and transport in Indus Valley's trade industry?
